Payment of CCDF Co-Payments during a Declaration of Emergency or Disaster

POLICY:

- I. Payment of Child Care Co-Payments
 - a. During a declared period of emergency or disaster, subject to the Governor signing a proclamation of a State of Emergency or Disaster, providers may be paid based on the enrollment status of subsidy families up to the Declaration end date subject to the availability of funds.
 - b. Co-payments will be paid up to the current maximum CCDF rate. However, if the provider rate is lower than the maximum CCDF rate, the co-payment will be paid up to the provider rate.
 - i. 100% of Co-payments and overage costs may be paid by the program subject to the availability of funds.
 - c. Coverage of co-payments and overages may be extended after Declaration end date for at least 6 months but no more than 12 months as transitional relief and support to families, subject to the availability of funds.
 - d. Example Scenarios relative to item b. above:

Ex #1. Family A has a 30% co-payment. Children are 2 and 3 years of age.

- Ex #2. Family B is at 100% subsidy. Children are 2 and 3 years of age.

 Subsidy will be paid up to \$575 for the 2-year-old and up to \$570 for the 3-year-old.
- Ex #3. Family C has a 30% co-pay. Children are 2 and 3 years of age.

 Provider Maximum is \$525 for up to 35 months / CCDF Maximum is \$575

 Provider Maximum is \$510 for up to 47 months / CCDF Maximum is \$570

 Subsidy will be paid up to \$525 for the 2-year-old and up to \$510 for the 3-year-old.
- Ex #4. Family D is at 100% subsidy. Children are 2 and 3 years of age.

 Provider Maximum is \$525 for up to 35 months / CCDF Maximum is \$575

 Provider Maximum is \$510 for up to 47 months / CCDF Maximum is \$570

 Subsidy will be paid up to \$525 for the 2-year-old and up to \$510 for the 3-year-old.

This policy provides guidance to staff on how to address the payment of subsidy co-payments during the declaration of emergency or disaster.
